5. A copy of your Master thesis in Business Administration or a comparable academic thesis; if your Masters degree had no thesis requirement, we need a copy of any academic output or journal articles you may have written.
6. Two (2) letters of recommendation to be sent directly to the school, or in a sealed and signed envelope to be included within the application package.

If you have not received your Masters degree from SSE, or are not currently enrolled at SSE, please also send:

7. A description of how exams are graded at your university/college.
8. A copy of the official test result of either the GRE (Graduate Record Examination) or GMAT (Graduate Management Admission Test) result. Our current average is 650.
9. For non-native speakers of English, a copy of the official test results for TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) or IELTS (International English Language Testing System) is helpful to us.
