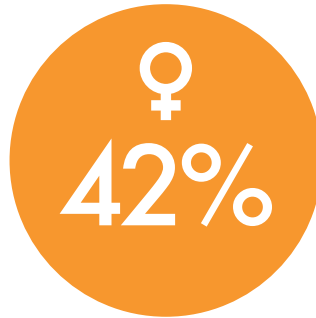

GRADUATE PROFILE

In 2017, 307 students graduated from SSE's Master programs. They included 58 percent men and 42 percent women. Median age at graduation was 25. In total 36 different nationalities were represented.

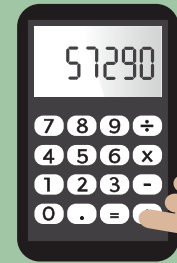
94 percent found employment within three months of completing their studies.*

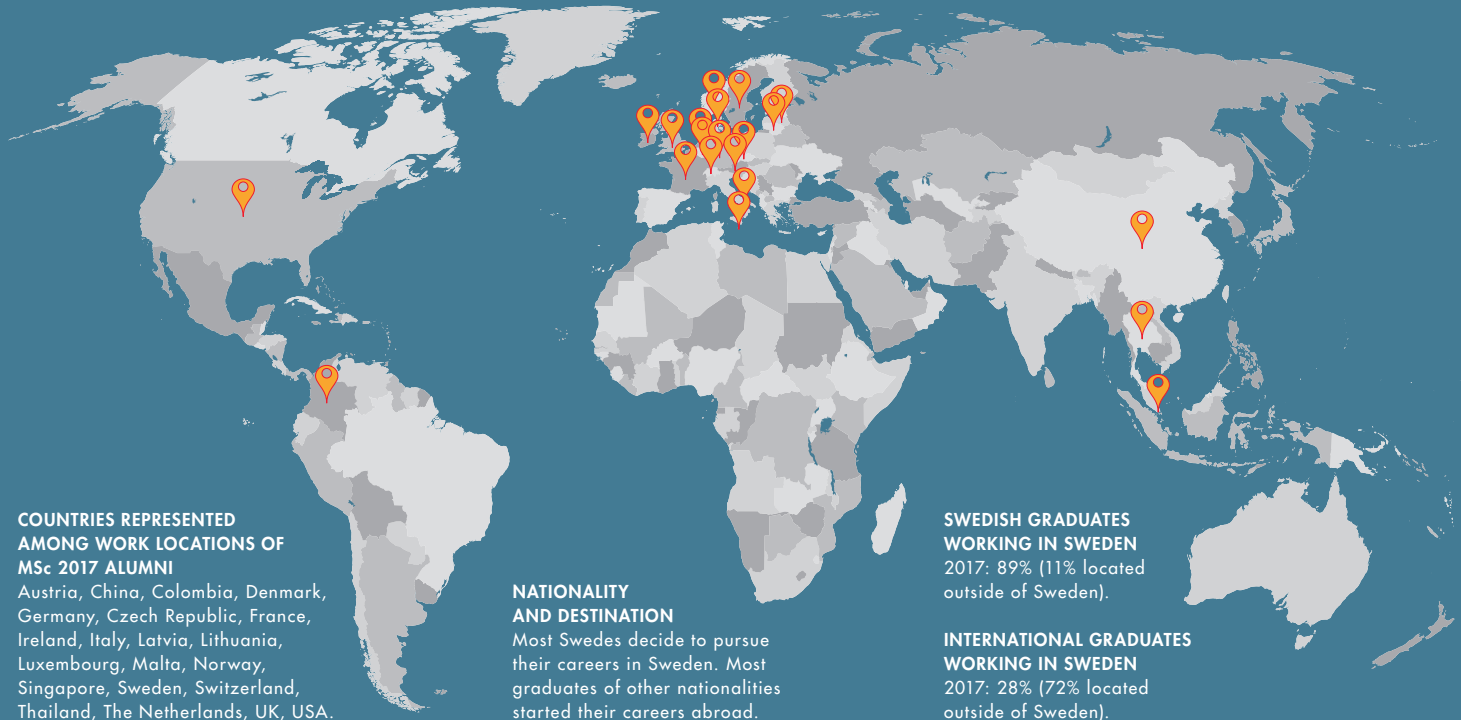
The average total compensation of Master graduates one year after completing their studies was 57 290 USD* (488 959 SEK).

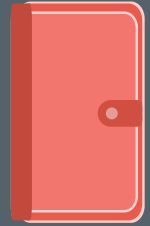
