



Single family homes: 88/34%





Two children family in single family home - 5 500 kr


Unemployed - 2 200 kr


Guaranteed pensioner, unmarried - 300 kr


Retired couple in rental property - 2 000 kr




Two children family in tenant owner rights with different loan to value ratios
