Authoritarian Regime

- Two types of authoritarian regimes
- electorate (Hugo Chavez) is based on social bribery
- 2. elite (Leonid Kuchma), based on bribery of elite



- The previous module of economic growth, based on oil price growth and illegal schemes of oil trade, came to its end
- Elites' support is lost. Lukashenko's ranking is 20-30%

- To get back electorate support. New program of social housing

- If the previous source of financing of social bribery was used up, the new source should be found
- Modernization of the economy will lead to the rise in the efficiency of production and to sustainable financing of social programs

Challenges for Lukashenko

 The current experience proves the efficiency of this kind of path: modernization of the oil refineries and investment in the milk products industry



- The new source of financing is needed. This source is privatization.
- Privatization: expensive entities with the minimum number of employees



- Investment in infrastructure
- 1. It gives return (electric power industry)
- 2. Small and medium cities (the most significant decrease of Lukashenko's ranking)
