



PhD FINANCE

The PhD Program in Finance at SSE follows the standard US format: rigorous coursework in the first two years, and independent work on research projects that will make up the doctoral dissertation in the last two years. A specially designed course program, the Stockholm Doctoral Course Program in Economics, Econometrics and Finance (SDPE), is organized by SSE jointly with Stockholm University for our doctoral students in Economics and Finance.

PHD PROGRAM IN FINANCE

5 YEARS | **240** ECTS

In order to receive a PhD degree in Finance from SSE, you must earn 240 ECTS (four years). These credits consist of a coursework component (105 ECTS) and a dissertation component (135 ECTS). In the first year, the coursework component consists of seven courses (45 ECTS) integrated in the SDPE program, and two additional finance courses (15 ECTS). In the second year, the coursework consists of three finance courses (22.5 ECTS), as well as elective courses (22.5 ECTS), where you can take more finance courses, including shorter mini courses on specialized areas in finance, or topic courses in economics.

Teaching experience and seminars are integral parts of the PhD program in Finance and entitles you to a fifth year. From the second year you are encouraged to do some teaching in addition to research assistance and to participate in finance seminars and workshops.

By the end of the second year, you will have found a research topic that excites you and a suitable supervisor for your dissertation. You will spend your final years completing your dissertation. Research and conference travels are encouraged, and travel stipends for mini courses and PhD workshops are available through the Swedish House of Finance (SHoF).

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1) PROVEN ACADEMIC RECORD

We require a university level degree and one year of Master level studies or the equivalent. We will also consider students with a very strong record from a four-year university program.

2) ECONOMICS OR FINANCES COURSES

In order to be eligible for the PhD Program in Finance, you need to have at least three semesters of economics or finance courses (90 ECTS) including a thesis worth at least 15 ECTS.

3) GRE TEST

All applicants to the Finance Program are required to take the general GRE test. The GMAT test may be taken instead, but the GRE is preferred. There is no minimum score requirement for any of the tests.

4) PROOF OF PROFICIENCY IN ENGLISH

Unless you are a native English speaker or have undertaken a university study program in English, you need to provide evidence of your English proficiency. We prefer that you take the TOEFL test, but the IELTS test may also be taken. There is no minimum score requirement for any of the tests.

5) MOTIVATION & SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

- Resume/full CV
- Photocopy of your valid passport
- Official Transcripts for College/University Degrees and Courses, and Degree Certificates
- One copy of your most advanced thesis/essay within economics (in English)
- A Statement of Purpose: a concise statement concerning your plans for PhD studies, your research interests and your career objectives
- Three contacts for recommendation

TUITION FEES

SSE does not charge tuition fees for the PhD programs. All admitted PhD students receive a scholarship from the SSE, and are guaranteed funding throughout the PhD program, conditional upon satisfactory performance.
