The Stockholm School of Economics (SSE) opened its doors to its first students in 1909 and has since become one of Europe's leading business schools. Built on a foundation of world-class research, our programs – ranging from Bachelor, Master and PhD degrees to Executive MBA and executive education programs – are developed in close collaboration with both the research and the business communities. This ensures our students gain the knowledge, skills, and networks needed to excel in leadership roles across industries.

At SSE, an innovative transformation is taking place. At its core is the introduction of the FREE model, an educational mission that aims to prepare future leaders for a complex and interconnected world. FREE stands for Fact-based, Reflective, Empathetic, and Entrepreneurial, values essential to fostering sound judgment and adaptability in leadership.

GRADUATE PROFILE

In 2024, 351 alumni graduated from SSE's two Bachelor programs. The group consisted of 38% women and 62% men. The median age at graduation was 23 and 30 nationalities were represented.

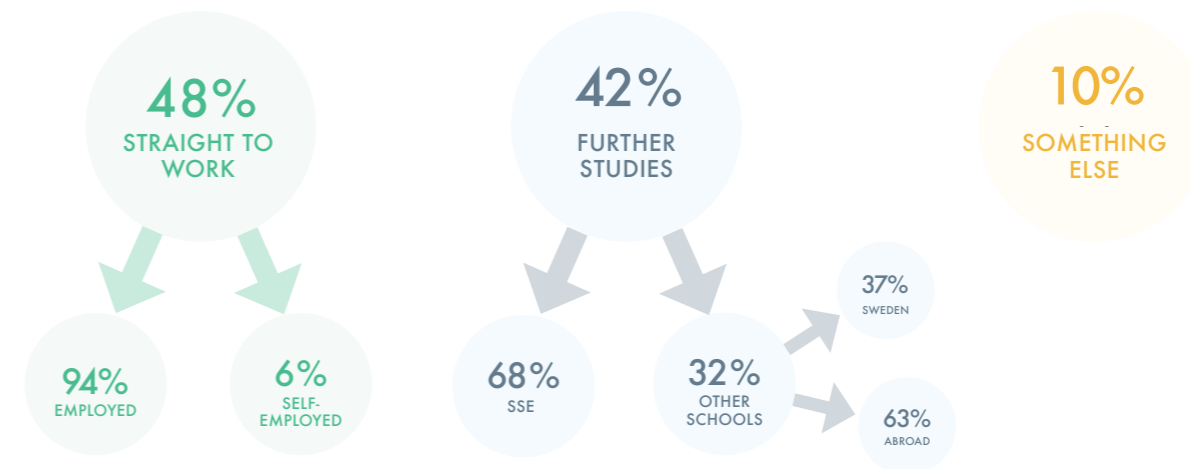

WHAT COMES NEXT?

In the spring of 2025, the 351 alumni who graduated from SSE's Bachelor programs in 2024 were surveyed about their whereabouts, employment situation and remuneration. A total of 293 alumni responded to the survey. Their answers are summarized on the following pages.

Please note that not all respondents completed every question. Percentage values are calculated based on the number of valid responses to each specific question. Throughout the following pages, the term "alumni" refers to those who answered each respective survey question, not the entire 2024 graduating cohort. Company sector information was reviewed by the project team and standardized according to the Financial Times classification system.

REACH YOUR ENTREPRENEURIAL DREAM

Since its inception in 2001, SSE Business Lab has supported over 300 companies, among them well-known successes like Klarna, Budbee and Voi Technology. In 2025, half of last year's leading hubs in the Financial Times' ranking vanished from the list, while SSE Business Lab surged ahead. Now ranked eighth among Europe's leading start-up hubs, SSE's incubator is the only Nordic hub to earn a place in the top ten.

SSE Business Lab is an integrated part of the School and encourages entrepreneurship within the SSE community. Open to students, alumni, and faculty, the lab offers early-stage support to ventures with at least one co-founder connected to SSE. The incubator helps startups develop their ideas, accelerate growth, and create impact, through coaching, mentorship, workshops, and access to a first-class network of investors.

ABOUT LOVISA QVARNER AND DIBZ

Lovisa attended the BSc program in Business & Economics from 2017 to 2020. Towards the end of her studies, she founded Dibz together with two friends from KTH Royal Institute of Technology. Coming from smaller cities, they were frustrated by the complexity of housing queues in Stockholm and wanted to create a simpler solution for people looking for accommodation.

Dibz is a platform that allows users to keep track of all their housing queues and points in a single place. The platform aims to help its users plan their future and maximize their opportunities with just a couple of clicks. As a platform that democratizes access to information, Dibz seeks to promote social inclusion by making it easier for everyone to navigate the complex housing market in Sweden.

ACCESS THE SSE NETWORK

At SSE, corporate collaboration is part of our DNA. Through the SSE Corporate Partnership Program, we work closely with over 90 leading Swedish and international companies across industries. These partnerships create real opportunities for exposure to leading employers through internships, case studies, on-campus recruitment events, and mentorship programs.

SSE is also a member of CEMS, the global alliance of leading business schools, which includes over 70 corporate partners. Only one school per country is allowed to join CEMS and all members are top institutions in their respective countries.

BSC ALUMNI WORK IN THE FOLLOWING SECTORS

38% finance, 23% consultancy, 7% technology, 6% healthcare 4% non-profit organizations, 4% consumer products, 4% energy/utilities, 4% industrial, 3% retail, 7% other.

BSC ALUMNI WERE HIRED QUICKLY

Of the alumni who told us that they went straight to work and disclosed their time to employment,

91% found employment within three months of completing their studies.*

Out of those who found employment within three months of completing their studies,

78% found positions before they completed their studies.

528,164 SEK or 52,711 USD - the average annual gross salary for employed alumni just one year after graduation.**

*The remaining 9% include alumni who chose not to look for a job immediately after graduation.

**Alumni were asked to provide their salary in a currency of their choice. The currency was converted to USD and SEK using Riksbank's exchange rate on April 8, 2025; USD 1 = SEK 10,02. Outliers were excluded from this analysis. This figure includes bonuses and commissions.

WORK LOCATIONS OF BSc 2024 ALUMNI

More than 80% of SSE graduates start their careers in Sweden, but international pathways are increasingly common. The United Kingdom (4%), the United States (3%), Germany (2%), and Spain (2%) top the list of popular destinations.

Other countries included Canada, Denmark, France, Ireland, Malta, Mongolia and Switzerland.

74% of international BSc graduates start their professional journey in Sweden.
